- Conducting field monitoring to quantify and characterise vegetation, and implement monitoring programs, and contribute to the broader team for vegetation (and ecosystem) identification, ensuring consistency and continuity of landscape assessment.
- Engaging and liaising with landholders (commonly pastoral landowners and/or lessees).
- Supporting other project activities as required, including reporting and project co-design.

Other Role Requirements

- You will need to be an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- A current driver's licence, experience/training with 4WDs/UTVs, experience with remote area work and First Aid in Remote Situations certification is required.
- Experience and certification in the storage, transport and application of chemical herbicides is required.
- Ability to travel as required regular away from home travel is likely to be required, including to remote locations.
- Experience in the management and supervision of contractors including quality control of supplier's goods/services.
- Excellent communication skills and a commitment to safe work polices/procedures at all times.
